

Janusz Poliński: Cargo Operations in Railway Transport

The monograph entitled “Cargo Operations in Railway Transport” continues the monograph series published within the Railway Research Institute’s Railway Track and Operation Department. Basic components of cargo operations, i.e. loads, packaging and loading units, means of rail transport to carry them as well as loading machines and equipment are described in seven chapters. Technological processes of cargo operations relating to reloading, preparing the load for transport, servicing loads on the joint of different gauge tracks are presented in detail. The annex includes definitions of basic notions, explanation of acronyms and abbreviations used as well as other explanatory notes.
